



## **Reopening Guidelines - May 2021**

### **Check In**

- Upon arrival, temp will be taken as you enter the auditorium
- If you have a temperature of 100.4 or higher, we you will be respectfully asked to exit the facilities.
- Check-in is mandatory for kids ministry
- Masks & hand sanitizer will be available if requested; but not required
- Family units are encouraged to sit together

### **During Service**

- Observe social distancing guidelines: limit physical contact; cough and sneeze into elbow
- An offering bucket will no longer be passed but will be available at the back of the auditorium, near the kids check in. online giving will continue to be encouraged
- When communion is offered, we will provide prepackaged communion elements

### **After Service**

- Please exit the auditorium promptly so we can prepare for Abundant Life and feel free to socialize outside
- If you have kids in kids ministry, please pick them up promptly and follow the one way directional signs to exit the building

### **Kids Ministry**

- If you cannot make it to the service, the Gospel Project curriculum and activities will continue to be posted online

### **Online Services**

- If you do not feel comfortable attending at this time, you are still a vital part of this ministry and we want to serve you faithfully.
- You can watch the service live on our PCC Facebook or Youtube page. It will start on Sundays at 9:30am
- As mentioned above, kids ministry activities will continue to be posted online
- To keep everyone well informed of all activities, events, and programs, we will continue posting this information on our website and social media pages

**Precautions Taken**

- In an effort to keep our congregation healthy and safe, we have brought in a third party cleaning service for the campus. They will come in weekly to clean and sanitize all bathrooms, classrooms, hallways, auditorium, and touch surfaces.
